## Options For Adding More Storage

### iCloud storage

For just \$0.99/month you can upgrade to the 50 GB iCloud storage plan and enjoy the convenience of automatic, worry-free backups. No further action is required of you and all of your items are automatically, safely and securely backed up for a low monthly cost.

On your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch


- Go to Settings > [your name] > iCloud > Manage Storage or iCloud Storage.
- Tap Buy More Storage or Change Storage Plan.
- Choose a plan.
- Tap Buy and follow the onscreen instructions.

### GOOGLE PHOTOS

If you're using iOS 10.2 or earlier, go to Settings > iCloud > Google Photos since it has free unlimited storage and photos can then be deleted from the phone without losing them for good like you would with iCloud.

## Apple iCloud Backup

- Select the **Settings Icon** (Gray Gear )
- Select **iCloud**
- Ensure Photo's, Contacts, and Messages are toggled ON. Also, toggle on any other features you would like saved.
- Select **iCloud Backup**
- Toggle On **iCloud Backup**
- Select **Back Up Now**. After the first backup, the device will automatically back up when it is connected to power, locked, and on Wi-Fi. If there is already an iCloud back up, the date and time will display under the "Back Up Now".



## Apple iTunes Backup

- Open iTunes on your computer
- Plug your phone into the computer and select **Trust** on the phone
- Select **Continue** on the iTunes popup message to Allow Access to the Phone
- Select **Setup as New Phone**
- Select **Get Started**
- Select **Back Up Now**
- iTunes will begin the device backup
- iTunes shows the latest back up under **Latest Backup**.

### Manually Back Up and Restore

Manually back up your iPhone to this computer or restore a backup stored on this computer.
